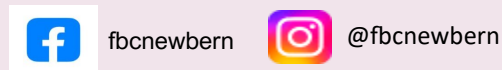

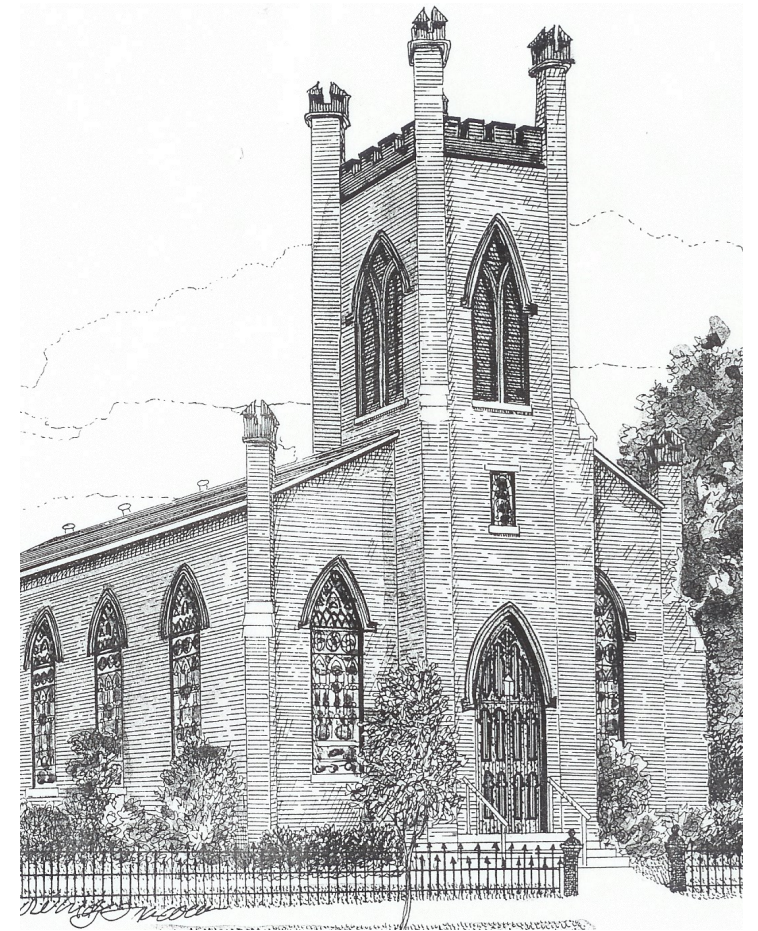


God's Invitation to You!
